### **RESEARCH PROPOSAL SUBMISSION SYSTEM 2023**

In 2023, the research submission system for class 2020 students has 2 options, there are:

- 1. Consultation and discussion with Agribusiness Lecturers
- 2. Research Proposal Submission Acceleration Program

More detaied description of each option:

### 1. Consultation and discussion with Agribusiness Lecturers

- In this option, the lecturer who is invited to discuss and consult automatically becomes a supervisor, with the following conditions:
  - a. Have carried out consultations and discussions with lecturer concerned, accompanied by evidence of statements from the lecturer concerned (Appendix 1)
  - b. Have a research topic that contains (name, NIM, title, background, research objectives, bibliography using mendelay)
  - c. The research topic is equipped with 1 main journal (International Journal / Accredited National Journal) and 9 supporting journals (International Journal/National Journal)
  - d. Letter of approval ro carry out research from research locations in companies (if research is in companies, KUD, cooperatives, banks, LPD, etc.), for research in subak, vilagge and sub-disctrict object is not necessary. Letter templates are in Appendix 2.
  - e. Submission of research to a company unit must meet the company requirements determined by KPUP
  - f. 1 lecturer in this option is only given a maximum quota of 5 students
  - g. Submission of research proposal (according to SOP for Submission of Research Proposals on the next page)

### 2. Research Proposal Submission Acceleration Program

• If the students follow this program, students must prepare the following equipment:

- a. Make a topic based on the recommendation of KPUP topic (Appendix 3) and research containing (name, NIM, title, background, research objectives and bibliography using mendelay) → brought to the workshop
- Research topic include 1 main journal (International Journal / Accredited National Journal) and 9 supporting journals (International Journal / National Journal)
- c. Letter of approval to carry out research from research locations in companies (if research is in companies, KUD, cooperatives, banks, LPD, etc.) for research in subak, village and sub-district objects is not necessary.
   The letter templates is in Appendix 2 → brought to the workshop
- d. Submission of research to a company unit must fulfill the company requirements determined by KPUP
- e. Participate in a workshop to accelerate the submission of research proposals which will be carried out on May 31, 2023, until complete
- f. After attending the workshop, students will be distributed with thesis advisors → submission of research proposals (according to the SOP for Submission of Research Proposals on the next page)

# THE SOP OF RESEARCH PROPOSAL SUBMISSION THESIS BACHELOR OF AGRIBUSINESS 2023

### MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Active students (not on leave)
- 2. Students have taken a minimum of 90 credits, as evidenced by a temporary grade transcript signed by Vice Dean 1 and each students academic advisor (example of Appendix 4)
- 3. Maximum 2 sheets of topics (containing full name, NIM, handphone number, Title of Proposal Research, Background, Research objectives and Bibliography using mendelay)
- 4. The research topic is accompanied by 1 main journal (International Journal / Accredited National Journal) and 9 supporting journals (International Journal / National Journal)
- 5. If the Research Objects are AGRIBUSINESS COMPANIES, COOPERATIVES, AGRIBUSINESS INSTITUTIONS, LPD (Village Credit Institutions), Must comply with the provisions (Attachment 2):
  - a. The company must have a legal entity
  - b. The minimum number of employees is 50 people or an turnover of 1 billion / year.
- 6. Statement from the lecturer concerned (Appendix 1) → specifically for students with the option of Consultation and discussion with Agribusiness lecturers
